Dr. Williams' journey as a volunteer physician began early in his career. While practicing medicine in Birmingham, Alabama, he dedicated time to serve at a clinic for the medically indigent, ensuring that those most in need received the care they deserved.

Once he retired, Dr. Williams moved to Colorado in 2008 where he began practicing as a volunteer physician at Clinica Tepeyac. In 2011, Clinica Colorado opened its doors to the uninsured and underserved community and he became a weekly volunteer provider—a commitment he maintained for 16 years. His service goes beyond patient care; he has served on Clinica Colorado's Board of Directors since 2011, supported fellow providers, and delivered educational lectures on gastroenterology to staff and volunteers.

Dr. Williams is known as a wealth of knowledge, always willing to teach and support those around him. Through his tireless work, he has bridged cultural divides, uplifted the underserved, and inspired those around him to serve with compassion and humility. His legacy is one of selfless service, education, and unwavering dedication to the well-being of others.
